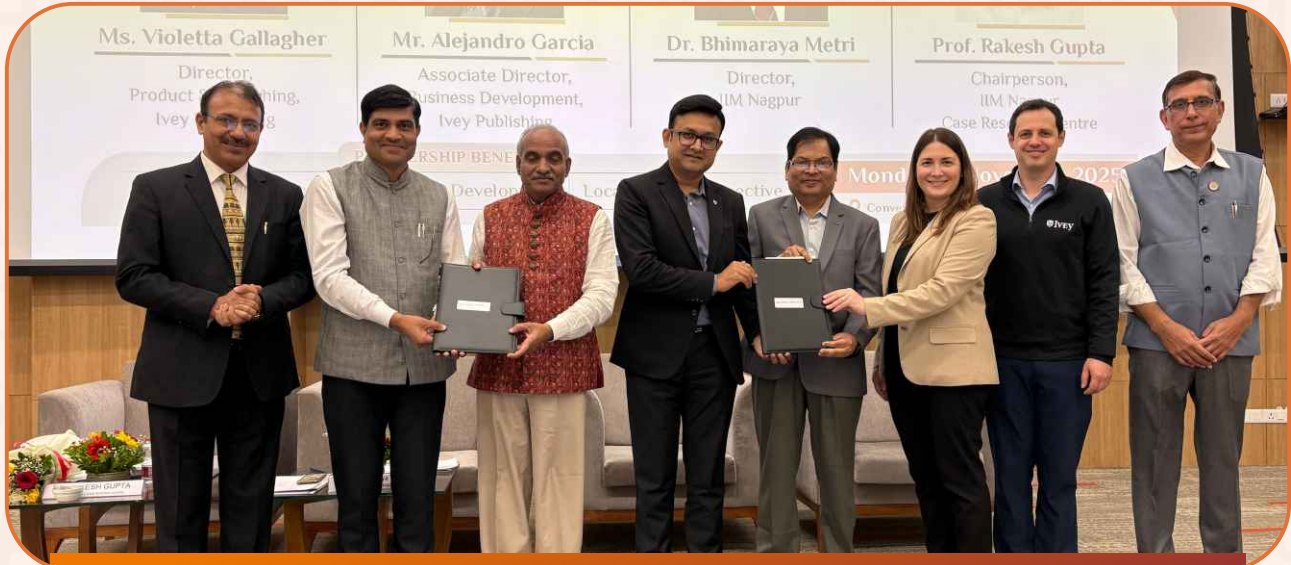

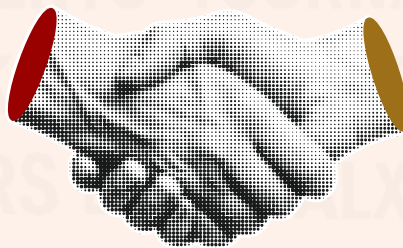

This award has added yet another prestigious feather to Sanjivani's cap, the institute stated in its press release.

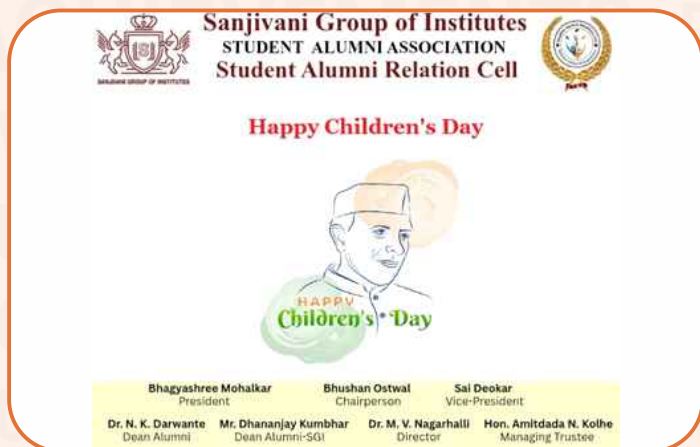

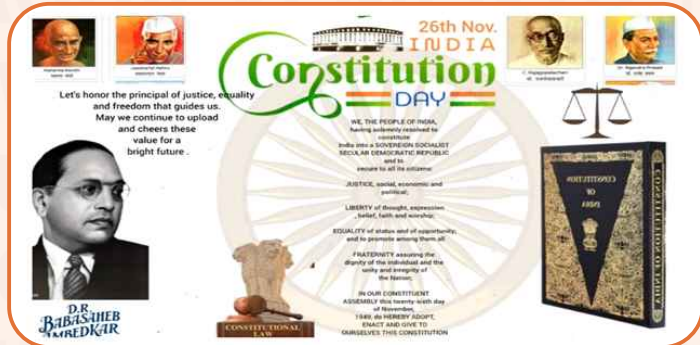

School of Sciences Observes National Constitution Day with Preamble Reading and Awareness Session

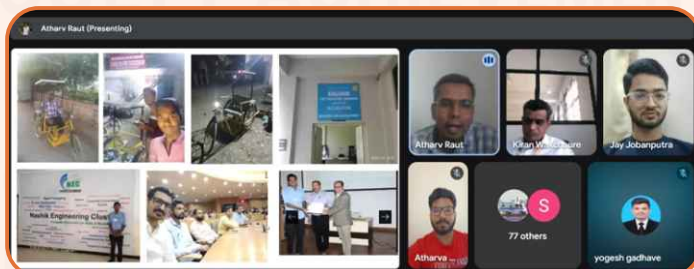

Sanjivani University Strengthens Global Academic Ties Through High-Impact Visit to Taiwan and Shenzhen



Kopargaon: In a major step toward expanding international academic and research opportunities, Sanjivani University successfully concluded a high-level scientific visit to Taiwan and the People's Republic of China (Shenzhen) from 19 to 27 November 2025. The visit, led by Dr. S. B. Dahikar, Dean, , aimed at establishing global collaborations, identifying internship and doctoral pathways, and enhancing the university's international presence.

The visit resulted in significant progress on academic partnerships, student mobility programs and research opportunities across leading universities, institutes, and industries in both countries.

During the visit to Taiwan, Dr. Dahikar delivered an invited talk at the 15th International Conference on Lactic Acid Bacteria, where he interacted with researchers from multiple Asian nations. Prominent biotech and probiotic industry leaders such as Glac Biotech, Grape King Bio, and Yakult Probiotics Taiwan were identified as potential internship and placement destinations for Sanjivani students.

The visit also led to meaningful academic discussions at major Taiwanese institutions including National Cheng Kung University (NCKU), National Taiwan University (NTU), National Kaohsiung University of Science and Technology, and National Sun Yat-sen University.
